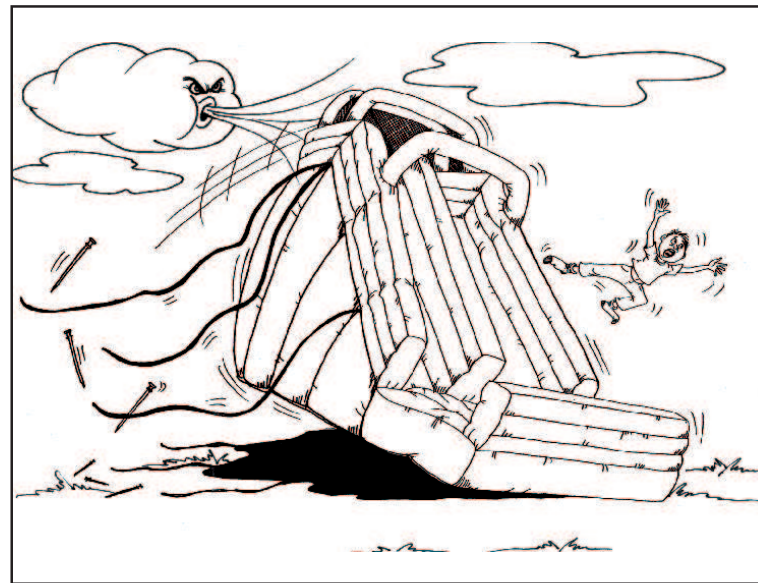


**Use and Indemnification:**

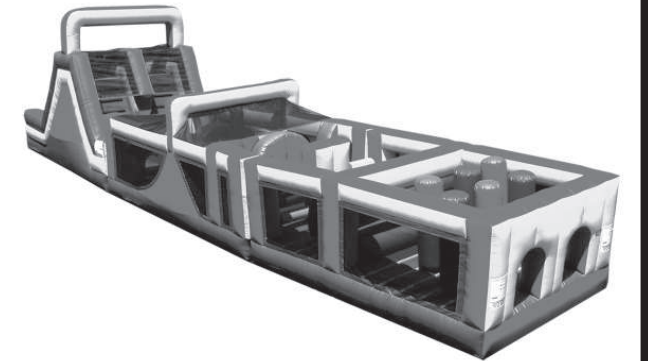

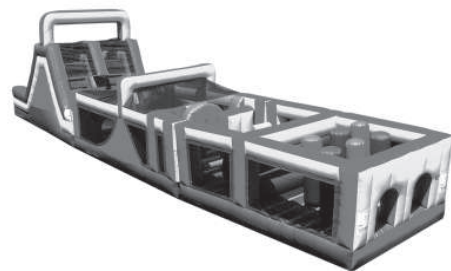

**Procedures for evacuation!**

Each blower tube has an automatic air flap that reduces the loss of air if the blower system goes off, however, all participants should be directed off the inflatable as shown by the arrow(s) below. In the event of a power outage or in an emergency take down, the participants should be directed to exit the slide and bouncer ASAP!

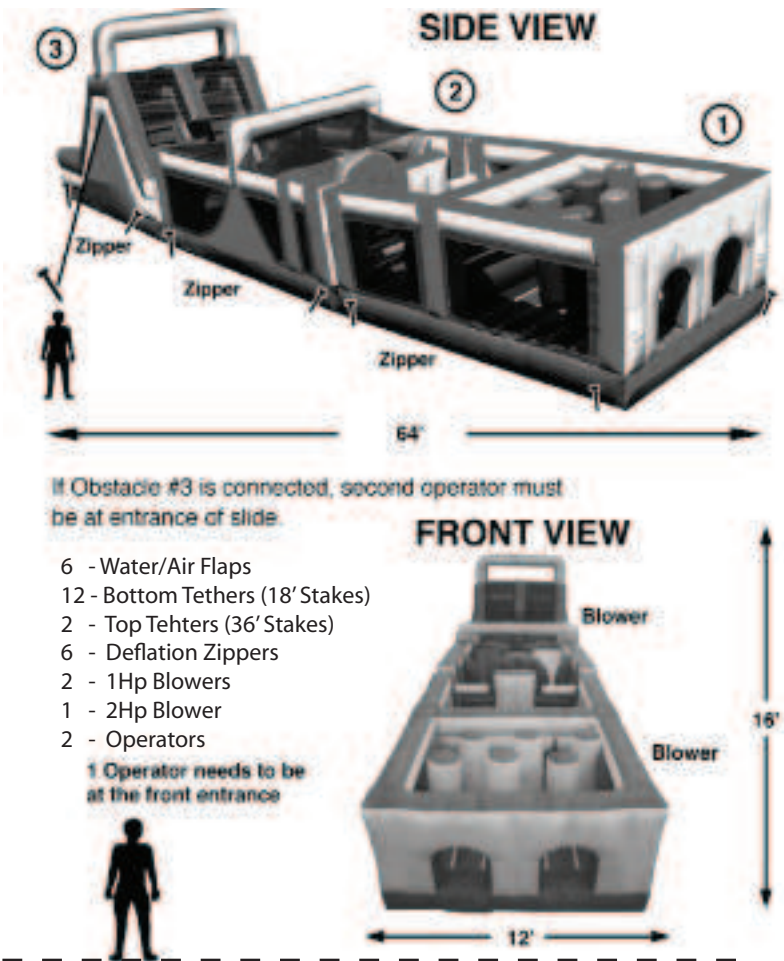

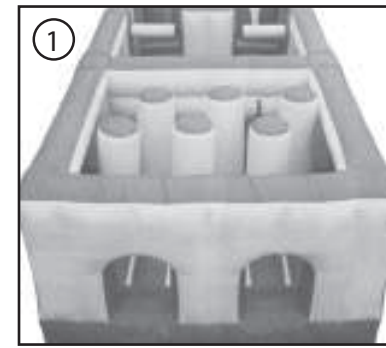
# Mega Obstacle Challenge Sections 1-2-3

## Directions

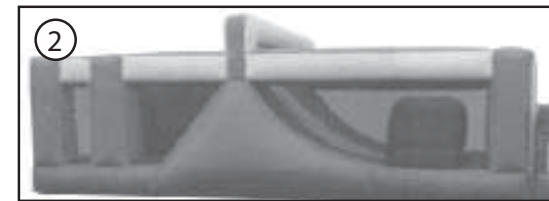
- Read "Installation and Setup Manual" completely.
- Layout ground tarps for inflatable (not provided)
- Remove units from storage bags.
- Position inflatables on tarps with a level ground area approximately 80' x 24'. Unit should have 5' of clearance on all sides with 18' height clearance.
- Connect units together before inflating (See Fig. A & B below)
- Connect first blower to obstacle section 1 air tube making sure strap is tight and secure.
- If using Obstacle #3 (Large Slide), connect second blower to air tube making sure strap is tight and secure.
- Close zipper(s) & water/air flaps on units
- Each blower requires dedicated 20 amp breaker. Do not plug both blowers into the same circuit!
- Turn blower(s) on.
- Secure all tethers firmly to stakes after units are fully inflated. Bury 18" stakes flush with ground.
- Do a safety check of slide and climb covers.
- Do a safety check on blowers and extension cords.
- Do a safety check on the interior and exterior surfaces of units looking for any moisture, debris, rips, tears or seams coming apart. (If noticed, do not use inflatable until repaired)
- Do not operate in winds over 15 m.p.h..



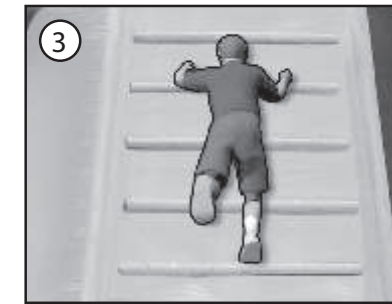
## Step by step Procedures for Mega Obstacle Challenge Section 1-2-3



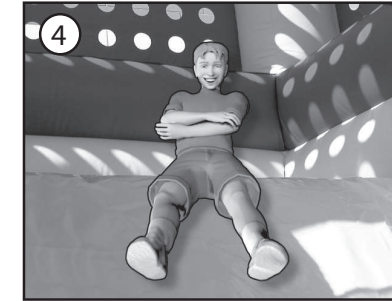
1. Enter unit and run through Pop-ups and then crawl through squeeze tubes. Then run through side tubes while staying on your side.



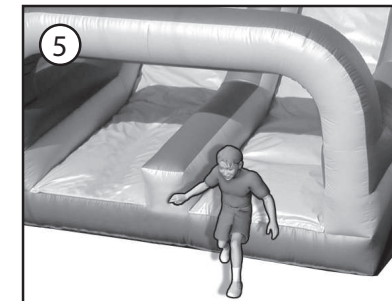
2. Run through a half moon wall and climb up small slide and slide down FEET FIRST only through small tunnel.



3. If connected, climb up Obstacle #3 Large Slide using both hands & feet to direct you to the top of the slide



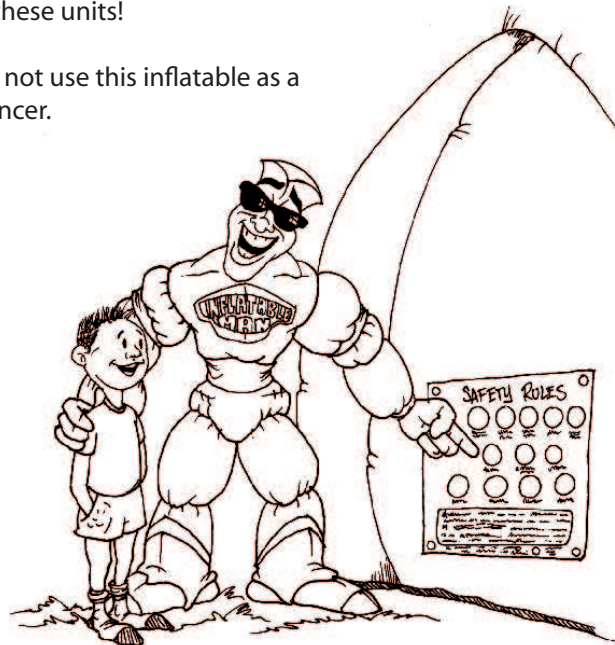
4. At the top of the LARGE SLIDE sit down with your arms crossed over your chest and slide down feet first only!



5. The winner is the first one to get to the bottom of the slide.

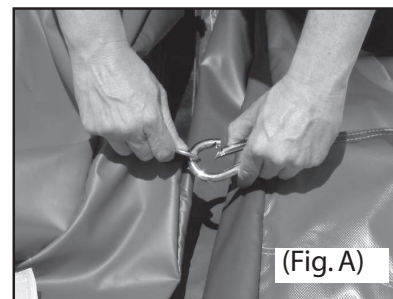
NEVER LEAVE THIS RIDE UNATTENDED!

- ADULT SUPERVISION IS REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES!
- ALWAYS INSTRUCT SAFETY!
- Instruct every participant to follow the Safety Rules on each inflatable.
- Never jump, flip, dive or somersault on or off of these units!
- Do not use this inflatable as a bouncer.

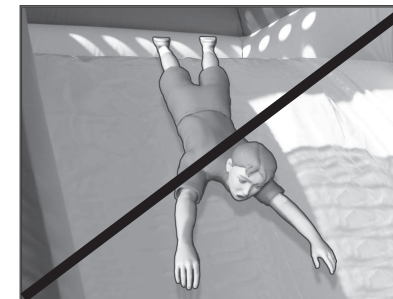


## To connect units, connection instructions below.

- Connect all units together before you turn on the blower(s). Connect units by clipping together. (See Fig. A)
- Velcro units together by inserting single velcro flap into the center of double velcro flap and seal tightly shut (See Fig. B)

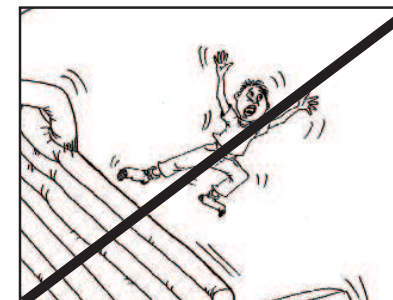


- AVOID INJURIES! DO NOT enter the slide lane head first!
- Be sure to sit down at the top of the slide with your feet out in front of you, then push off going feet first only.



NEVER JUMP OR FLIP OFF AN INFLATABLE!

- Always stay inside the walls of the inflatable.



KEEP LANDING AREAS CLEAR!

- Operators should not allow participants to slide down until slide landing area is clear of riders.



Operator must take control!

- Always have riders cross arms over chest with feet first before sliding down.



Be sure to instruct all operators of the correct procedures to have passengers follow as they ride the inflatable.

WARNING: The entrance operator should not allow the next 2 competitors to start until the first set of participants have reached top of slide.

- Instruct all passengers to ride individually.

No double riding!
